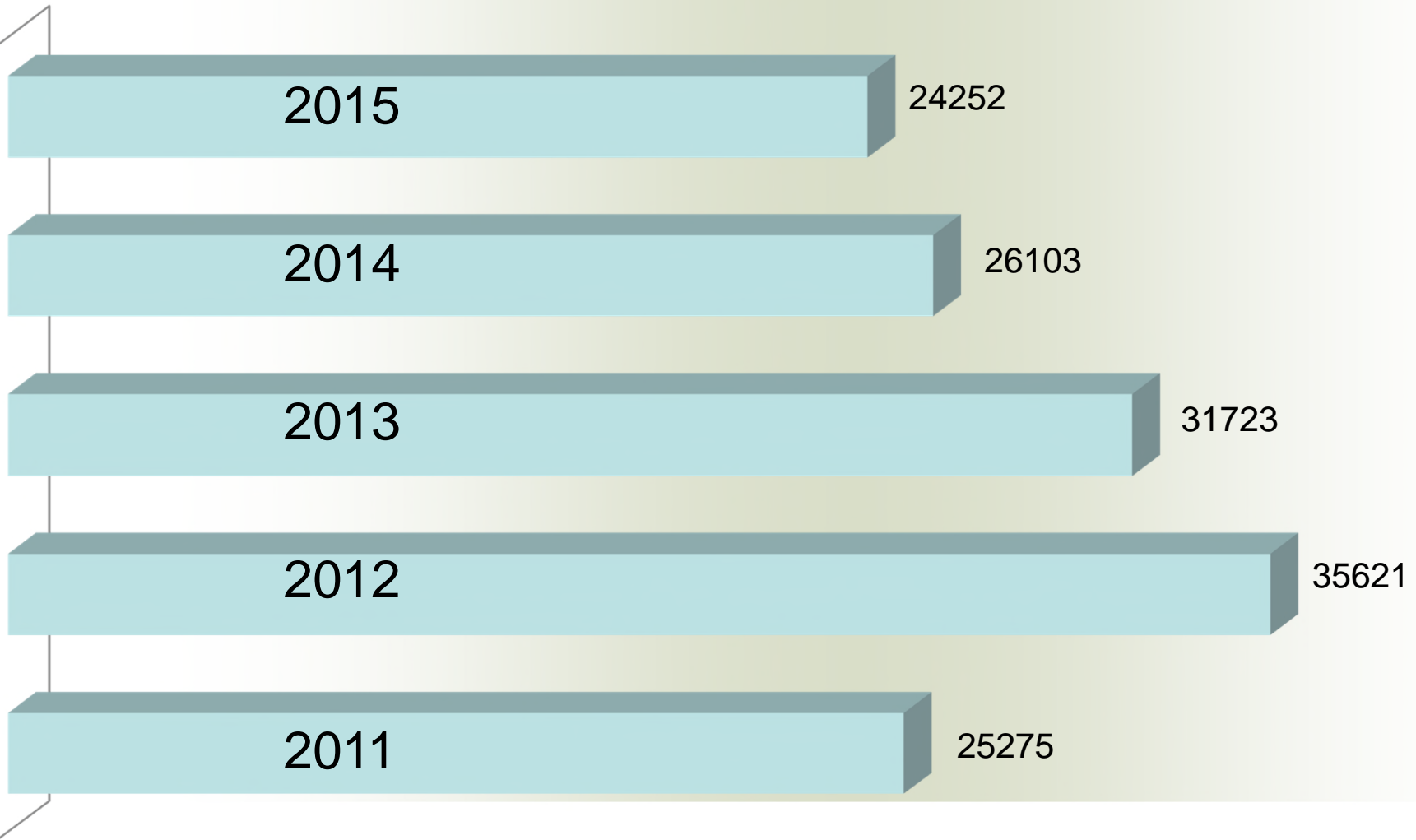
NSMA Objectives – www.nsma.org
